

Submit your OGP Idea and become a part of the change

Fundamental principles of the **Open Government Partnership (OGP)** - openness, transparency and accountability to the public, citizen engagement in the decision-making process are values of strategic importance to the Government of Georgia.

In order to enable greater citizen participation in open governance policy formation, **Open Government Georgia's Secretariat** (Administration of the Government of Georgia, Public Administration Unit) creates new opportunity for citizens to submit ideas and further contribute to the development of an open, accountable, transparent, citizen-oriented and participatory governance in Georgia.

How to Submit an Idea

OGP Idea can be submitted by filling out the registration form placed at the relevant tab of the OGP - Georgia's website.

In order to submit your idea registration/sign up on a website is not required. The fill out form requests of personal data (name and surname), e-mail address, phone number and a brief description of the idea. Additionally, to help OGP Georgia's Secretariat better understand your idea, the form allows submission of a separate file.

How to Select Relevant Idea

Idea to be reviewed by the OGP Georgia's Secretariat, must be relevant to at least one principle of the open governance: **transparency**, **accountability**, **engagement**, **access to public services**, and/or **technology and innovation**. At the same time, it is essential to comply with the registration form requirements - precisely describe the purpose of your idea, essence of the problem and suggested solution(s).

Processing Submitted Ideas

The Open Government Georgia's Secretariat shall review the submitted ideas at the end of each quarter and inform you about the respective decision by the end of next quarter by email.
